Notables include: Mark Calcavecchia, Bob Tway, Davis Love III, Lee Janzen, Chris Dimarco and Michelle McGann. 1995 Boys' Invitational Champion, Steve Scott went on to the 1995 semi-finals and 1996 finals of the U.S. Amateur.

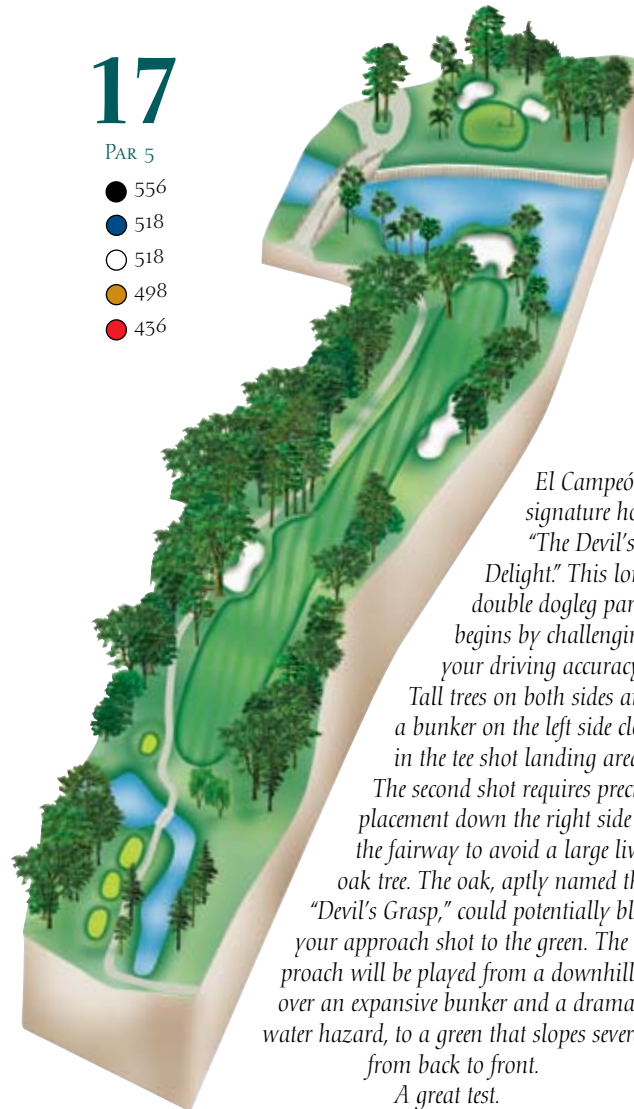

El Campeón's signature hole, "The Devil's Delight!" This long, double dogleg par 5 begins by challenging your driving accuracy.

Tall trees on both sides and a bunker on the left side close in the tee shot landing area.

The second shot requires precise placement down the right side of the fairway to avoid a large live oak tree. The oak, aptly named the "Devil's Grasp," could potentially block your approach shot to the green. The approach will be played from a downhill lie, over an expansive bunker and a dramatic water hazard, to a green that slopes severely from back to front.

A great test.

Tournament Information...

Format: Limited fields are chosen to compete in the Florida Junior Boys' and Girls' Invitational Championship. The event is a 3 day, 54 hole stroke play tournament amongst a strong field of junior golfers on two championship golf courses.

Eligibility: Each participant must be 8-18 years old and may not be attending a college or university. The age divisions are: 8-9, 10-11, 12-13, 14-15 and 16-18. The yardages for each age division are as follows:

Ages 8-11: Girls & Boys 2400-2600 yards (9 holes)

Ages 12-13: Girls 5100-5300 yards and Boys 5900-6100

Ages 14-18: Girls 5800-6000 yards and Boys 6500-6700

Registration Fee: Please enclose \$195⁰⁰ (\$145.00 for 8-11) with entry form. This fee includes **2 practice rounds**, 3 days of



tournament play, welcome gifts, daily breakfast, player family party, skills contest and 2 group golf clinics with renowned instructor, Gary Gilchrist. All entries must be received by Friday, **June 25, 2010. Refunds will be made if notified by Friday, June 25, 2010**

Regulations: USGA rules shall apply except as amended by the local rules committee. Golf carts and caddies are not allowed. Pull carts are allowed.

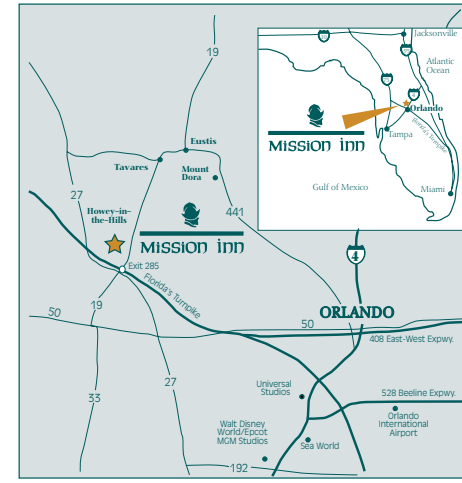
